Course Description: A428 Hardwick to Caxton Gibbet roundabout (RAB) and return

START (Grid Ref: - [TL3654659786](#)) on old A428 eastbound, about 120 yds west of Hardwick RAB, 40 yards west of western end of Armco barrier. Proceed to Hardwick RAB where 1st exit onto A428 westbound. Proceed under Cambourne flyover to TURN (4.63 mls) at Caxton Gibbet RAB (junction with A1198). Retrace A428 eastbound, under Cambourne flyover and under Hardwick flyover to FINISH (Grid Ref: - [TL3803859574](#)) in lay-by, about ¾ mile past Hardwick flyover, at a point 22 yards east of P sign. Notes

- **Size of Warning Signs** (where specified) relates to the size of the triangle i.e. Where not specified then a SMALL YELLOW sign 61cm x 48cm or larger may be used.
MEDIUM YELLOW 90cm x 60cm (<= 40mph)
LARGE WHITE sign 127cm x 102cm (> 40mph)
Rectangular KICKSTAND sign to be used at the START
- **All Marshals, and officials at start and finish should be supplied with and wear high visibility jackets.**
- All warning signs should be placed at least 100 yards before the relevant hazard. Marshals are specified where we consider there is a safety requirement and where necessary to indicate the route. It is the organiser's responsibility to post additional marshals where thought desirable.
- The small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garage, commercial premises, eatery, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered and are considered not to pose a significant risk.
- **Police Area(s) Cambridgeshire: - LOCAL REGULATIONS No.1 and 3 apply.**
Local Regulation No.1
No U turns should be made in sight of the start or finish areas while riding on the public highway.
Local Regulation No.3
No cars other than that of the timekeeper(s) and other event officials are to be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish points.
